The Government of Mozambique hereinafter called "Borrower" has received financing from the International Development Association (IDA) (the "Bank") toward the cost of the POWER EFFICIENCY AND RELIABILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (PERIP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the following two contracts:

- Lot 1: Redundancy in EdM Substations in Lichinga and Maputo
- Lot 3: Power Compensation System Protection and Control in Substation of Central and Northern Region

The Electricidade de Moçambique, E.P (EDM) now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for Lot 1 and Lot 3

Lot 1:

The scope comprises of measures at 14 Substations. These Substations are located mainly in the Maputo City and Maputo Province in the South of Mozambique, one substation is located at Lichinga in the Niassa Province in the northern Region of Mozambique.

The measures comprise the delivery and installation of several 66/11 kV transformers, one 66/33 kV transformer and one 110/33 kV transformer. Further installation of new AIS and GIS HV transformer bays, HV busbars, installation/replacement of protection and control system (including SCADA) as well as installation/extension of MV switchgear.

Lot 3:

The scope comprises of measures at 6 Substations. These Substations are located in central and northern Region of Mozambique.

The measures comprise the delivery/dismantling/installation/extension of protection and control systems (including SCADA) and delivery/installation/extension of HV equipment (220, 110 kV circuit breakers, disconnectors and current transformers); as well as one 33 kV metal clad switchgear. Further delivery/dismantling/installation/extension of one 15 Mvar compensation coil and one new 33 kV Statcom.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011, revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines.
